Ben LeRoy began with a presentation of information on the proposed Conservation District. Applicant representative Bill Stewart gave a presentation explaining why the group was interested in proposing a district, estimates that over 2,000 hours of time went into writing, researching and documenting the material for the application. There were 15 people who signed it. He believes that there are more supporters within the neighborhood.

Following the presentation, attendees had the opportunity to ask questions

Questions:

- Do supporters have the opportunity to counter protests?
- Question related to the skill sets required to participate in the Historic Preservation Commission.
- Some confusion was expressed relating to the formal protest and opposition testimony. Opposition testimony is registered, but formal protest follows state law, which then triggers an additional vote in favor by City Council in order for the district to be established. Bruce provided an excellent explanation.
- The applicants believe that the district should be approved in more than just one category.
- Councilman Gladney requested that the letters sent to residents following a (possible) nomination by Historic Preservation Commission should include if the property is nominated as Contributing or Non-Contributing.
- Mayor Feinen asked if a property were to be demolished, that what standards are used to review the Certificate of Appropriateness. Criteria like height, bulk, etc. are listed in the Zoning Ordinance. The specific design of the building is not prescribed.

- Seems to be confusion amongst the applicants about the criteria as well. The application includes common characteristics or attributes of the neighborhood. It is important that these are included in the application, because they help provide a summary of the area. If the district is passed, the application materials become the record of the district that HPC will reference when considering a C of A. However, the requirements that must be considered are in the Zoning Ordinance, the Conservation District application cannot create new requirements for the district.
- Question about the kinds of projects that need C of A's for Conservation Districts in the code. Slide in the presentation was very helpful.

Champaign County has not completed and submitted the 2019 audit by the required statutory deadline. This problem was not caused by RPC or RPC staff; RPC's audit work is done, but, as RPC is part of the County, until the rest of the County audit work is completed, an audit report for the County cannot be issued. While RPC could issue a separate audit report, as RPC is part of the County it would not count towards meeting the requirements and removing RPC from the State's Stop Payment list. RPC's budget is almost entirely comprised by State and federal

grants. Their cognizant agency at the State level is the Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity (DCEO). DCEO has made the determination that unless the County submits the required audit by March 17, the Stop Payment will be put into effect.

RPC staff stated that as of March 2, they were locked out of drawing down DCEO funds and effective March 17 will be locked out of all other Illinois Agency draw downs. The lock out will impact the whole County government.

County Auditor George Danos explained that funds received directly from the Federal Government are not currently impacted, but the Federal audit clearing house has communicated they are not in compliance, which may impact future Federal grants. The Stop Payment order also may be reported to the Designation Renewal System which will hurt RPC's standing with the Head Start program.

Auditor Danos stated that he was trying to remove the County from the Stop Payment List.

The County Treasurer and Circuit Clerk have still not completed bank reconciliations and/or financial statements for 2019. The 2019 County audit cannot be completed until these are complete.

Baker Tilly may help with Circuit Clerk completing Bank Reconciliations/ component financials (depending on staff availability.)

There is speculation that the 2020 Bank Reconciliations are also not completed, which will possibly delay the 2020 audit. The County Treasurer Cassandra Johnson indicated that they have been working on completing the 2020 Bank reconciliations.

RPC staff explained that this impacts \$18 million of current grants, not including any future funding such as funds available through the America Rescue Plan Act recently passed by Congress. The Stop Payment list is archived which will identify the County as a high-risk auditee for at least the next 3 years and may negatively impact the ability to get future grants.

The RPC board discussed requesting \$5.3 million in funding from the County to assist with cash flow between now and June. They also recommended that the County bring in external consultants or contractors to assist with the bank reconciliations needed to complete the audit. RPC staff also requested that the RPC Board of Commissioners create a task force to look at the structure and organization of RPC, potentially separating from Champaign County government, to mitigate compliance issues and ensure the long-term viability of the agency.

The RPC Board did not take any formal action at this meeting but supported sending a letter to Champaign County with their recommendations.
