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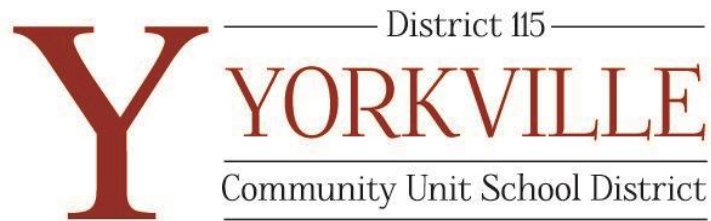

**RE: RESPONSE TO FOIA REQUEST**

Dear Check CU:

Thank you for writing to Yorkville Community Unit School District No. 115 (the “District”) with your request pursuant to the Illinois *Freedom of Information Act* (“FOIA”), 5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*, received on January 23, 2024. You requested the following:

“A copy of any recordings that may exist for the August 7th, 2023 Board of Education meeting.”

Your request is granted in part and denied in part. A recording is available at the District office for your inspection and/or copying on your behalf. Due to file size, the recording must be transferred on a flash drive. Please send us a mailing address and we will be happy to send it to you via US mail.

Portions of the closed session recording were redacted in compliance with the Attorney General’s binding opinion. Specifically, personal information that could identify a student and parent was removed pursuant to FOIA Section 7(1)(c). *See Chicago Alliance for Neighborhood Safety v. City of Chicago*, 348 Ill. App. 3d 188, 209, 211 (1st Dist. 2004) (“[T]he core purpose of the FOIA is to expose what the government is doing, not what its private citizens are up to.”); *see also* 5 ILCS 120/2.06; 5 ILCS 140/7(1)(a), (l); 5 ILCS 140/7.5(r). You may have a right to have this response reviewed by the Public Access Counselor (“PAC”) at the Office of the Illinois Attorney General. 5 ILCS 140/9.5(a). You can file your Request for Review with the PAC by writing to:

If you choose to file a Request for Review with the PAC, you must do so within 60 days of the date of this letter. 5 ILCS 140/9.5(a). Please note that you must include a copy of your original FOIA request and this letter when filing a Request for Review with the PAC. You also have the right to seek judicial review of any denial by filing a lawsuit in the State circuit court. 5 ILCS 140/11.

As the FOIA Officer for the District, I am responsible for responding to your request. If I have misinterpreted your request in any way, please contact me in writing.
