Thank you for writing to the Office of the Illinois Attorney General with your request for information pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.* (West 2020)).

In an e-mail received on October 29, 2021, you requested the following:

My understanding is that one or more City of Urbana officials has recently been in contact with the IAG regarding questions about FOIA as it relates to automated license plate readers. I am requesting any and all documents related to that correspondence. I think you could limit your search to the past 6 months, but if such a search reveals that correspondence was initiated earlier than that, please include correspondence back to the date of the initial inquiry. It is most likely that the correspondence was within the past 1-2 months.

I suspect beginning a search with simply "Urbana" and perhaps "ALPR" may quickly reveal what threads of correspondence may exist.

David Wesner


