On 3-12-18, at 1209 hrs. Officer Hurley, Bennett, and I were at the emergency room of OSF Hospital in Urbana reference a previous call.

I was standing near the doctor's desk when I noticed a white male wearing yellow scrubs walk up behind me. Based on my training and experience I knew that yellow scrubs at this hospital signified the individual is a psych patient. As I turned around the individual lunged forward with his arms extended out and reached for my duty weapon.

I swung my arm in a downward motion to free the subject's hand from my holster. The subject then assumed an aggressive stand and lunged at me again. I grabbed ahold of the subject and executed a hip toss, throwing him to the ground. Officer Hurley ran to assist me by grabbing ahold of the subject's arms. The subject continued to resist by tightening up and refused to comply with verbal orders to place his arms behind in back.

Officer Hurley and I used strong arm control to place the subject's arms behind his back and secure him in handcuffs. The handcuffs were double locked and checked for proper fit. The subject was picked up off the floor and escorted back to his room.

I later learned that the subject, [REDACTED], DOB [REDACTED] was brought to OSF in Urbana on 3-11-18 from Danville by his parents. According to OSF staff, [REDACTED] when he was admitted to the emergency room.

[REDACTED] advised staff he wanted to kill himself and even described the method in which he wished to accomplish the task. [REDACTED] describe his method as wanting to obtain a gun to shoot himself in the head. Staff advised me that [REDACTED].

OSF advised me that [REDACTED]

██████████. I entered ██████████ room and spoke with him briefly. ██████████ told me he hears voice and the voices told him the following: " if you kill yourself by blowing your brains out your friends in the military will not die". ██████████ told me he saw my pistol and wanted to take it and shoot himself. ██████████ said he has not been taking his medication because the voices tell him not too.

██████████ remained in handcuffs until he was ready to be transferred. Officer Hurley, Bennett, and I, along with two OSF security workers escorted ██████████ via wheelchair to the ██████████. Hospital policy does not allow weapons inside the unit so in the hallway Officer Bennett took photographs of ██████████ for evidence. Those photos were emailed to Evidence Technician Carr who uploaded them to the digital evidence archive. Officer Hurley removed the handcuff off of ██████████ left wrist and order him to place it on his head. I maintained control of ██████████ right arm. ██████████ then spun around with his left hand and attempted to grab my pistol again.

Using ██████████ right arm as leverage I executed an arm bar takedown and took him to the ground. On the ground ██████████ tucked his left arm under himself. I gave verbal commands to ██████████ to place his arm behind his back. ██████████ was given the opportunity and means to comply with verbal order but refused. Officer Hurley and I used strong arm control to place ██████████ left arm behind his back.

Officer's handcuffs were removed and replaced with OSF security handcuffs. None of the officers involved reported any injuries. I asked ██████████ if he had any injuries to report. ██████████ said no. OSF staff then escorted ██████████ into the unit.

No further information at this time.

NARRATIVE

On 3/12/18 Officer Bennett and I were operating as a two man training unit. At approximately 1146 hrs. we went with Officer Ruff to OSF Hospital while he transported [REDACTED] for a mental evaluation. While there we stood by in the Emergency Department speaking with staff.


At approximately 1205 hrs. I was standing facing room #5 at the nurses station. In the room was a white male dressed in yellow scrubs. These scrubs are used to identify patients who are seeking psychiatric/mental health evaluations.

Officer Ruff was positioned in front of me (one step closer to the room). While we stood there the male got up from the bed and exited his room. Officer Ruff saw this and began to turn and face towards the male. Officer Ruff and I both watched as the male slowly walked towards us. He kept his distance (to our right hand side) and appeared to me as if he was wanting to walk out of the E.D. doors.

I stated "hey" addressing the male. The male paused then stepped quickly towards Officer Ruff's right side with an out stretched arm and open hand. The male was looking intently at, while reaching towards, Officer Ruff's holstered handgun. The male was able to place his onto Officer Ruff's holster. Officer Ruff swung his hand downward removing the males hand from his holster. While doing so Officer Ruff turned his handgun away from the male while grabbing onto the male's shoulders.

As Officer Ruff was doing this I began reaching towards the male. Officer Ruff was able to complete a takedown on the male. As he went to the ground I ended up going onto the males legs. Officer Ruff placed his bodyweight onto the male's upper torso. I began giving the male loud verbal commands to place his hands behind his back. I could see that the male had his right hand pulled up and underneath of his chest. The male refused to

remove his hands from underneath of his body. I punched the male twice in his right side while still giving him verbal commands. The male immediately complied with my command and removed his right hand from underneath of his chest. I was able to properly secure the male's right hand in a handcuff.

The male still refused to take out his left hand from underneath of his body. I grabbed onto the males tri-cep muscle and squeezed. The male then complied and placed his left hand behind his back. I secured this hand into ~~a~~ the other handcuff and double locked them. Officer Ruff and I stood up the male and walked him, bent over, back into room #5. We were able to identify the male as [REDACTED].

Officer Ruff stood by with [REDACTED] while Officer Bennett made a call to Sgt. Charles. I exited the room to speak with E.D. and Crisis Staff. I was told that [REDACTED] [REDACTED] remained in handcuffs and was laid back onto his bed. [REDACTED] was on his right side and had a pillow underneath of his head. Officer Ruff spoke to [REDACTED] about what had happened and what was going on. See Officer Ruff's report for further. We exited the room but kept a close eye on [REDACTED] (through the open door and on the camera).

It was determined that [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] remained calm and had no outbursts while he was in his room. Officer Ruff, Officer Bennett and I assisted OSF Security Officers in taking [REDACTED] up to the [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was wheeled up in a wheel chair. He again was calm and made no statements. Upon getting off of the elevator we entered into a small short hallway. This is just before being able to enter into the secured [REDACTED].

Officer Bennett took two photographs of [REDACTED] face (red mark above his right eye) and of his foot. I also asked [REDACTED] if he was injured or was hurt from the takedown. [REDACTED] replied that he was not. I also lifted up [REDACTED] shirt to look at his right side. I saw no indication of any injuries or other marks.

I then instructed [REDACTED] that I was going to remove the handcuffs from his hands so that he can enter the [REDACTED]. I explained to [REDACTED] that I was going to remove his left hand and that I needed him to place it onto the

top of his head when I did so. [REDACTED] told me he would do so. Officer Ruff had maintained proper pressure/counter pressure on [REDACTED] right arm.

I released the handcuff and [REDACTED] began to place his hand onto the top of his head. I closed the cuff and maintained ahold of it with my left hand. I saw [REDACTED] tense up and Officer Ruff told [REDACTED] "don't do that". [REDACTED] then spun to his right and began to reach over towards Officer Ruff's right side (where Officer Ruff's holstered pistol was). Officer Ruff stated out loud "we're taking him to the ground" and did so with another takedown.

I had maintained ahold of the handcuff with my left hand. I did not want this to become a weapon if [REDACTED] began to swing his hand around. I saw that [REDACTED] was still reaching around Officer Ruff's waist and body. I yelled at [REDACTED] to stop grabbing Officer Ruff. I then punched [REDACTED] twice in his side. I was able to grab ahold of [REDACTED] left hand and presented it to Officer Bennett. She was able to place a set of her cuffs onto [REDACTED] wrists.

I removed my set of handcuffs and double locked Officer Bennett's. It was determined that OSF Security was going to walk [REDACTED] into the unit. A set of the security officers handcuffs were placed above Officer Bennett's so ours could be removed. Officer Ruff and I stood [REDACTED] up and he walked onto the [REDACTED] unit with OSF Security. This concluded our involvement and we left the floor and the hospital.

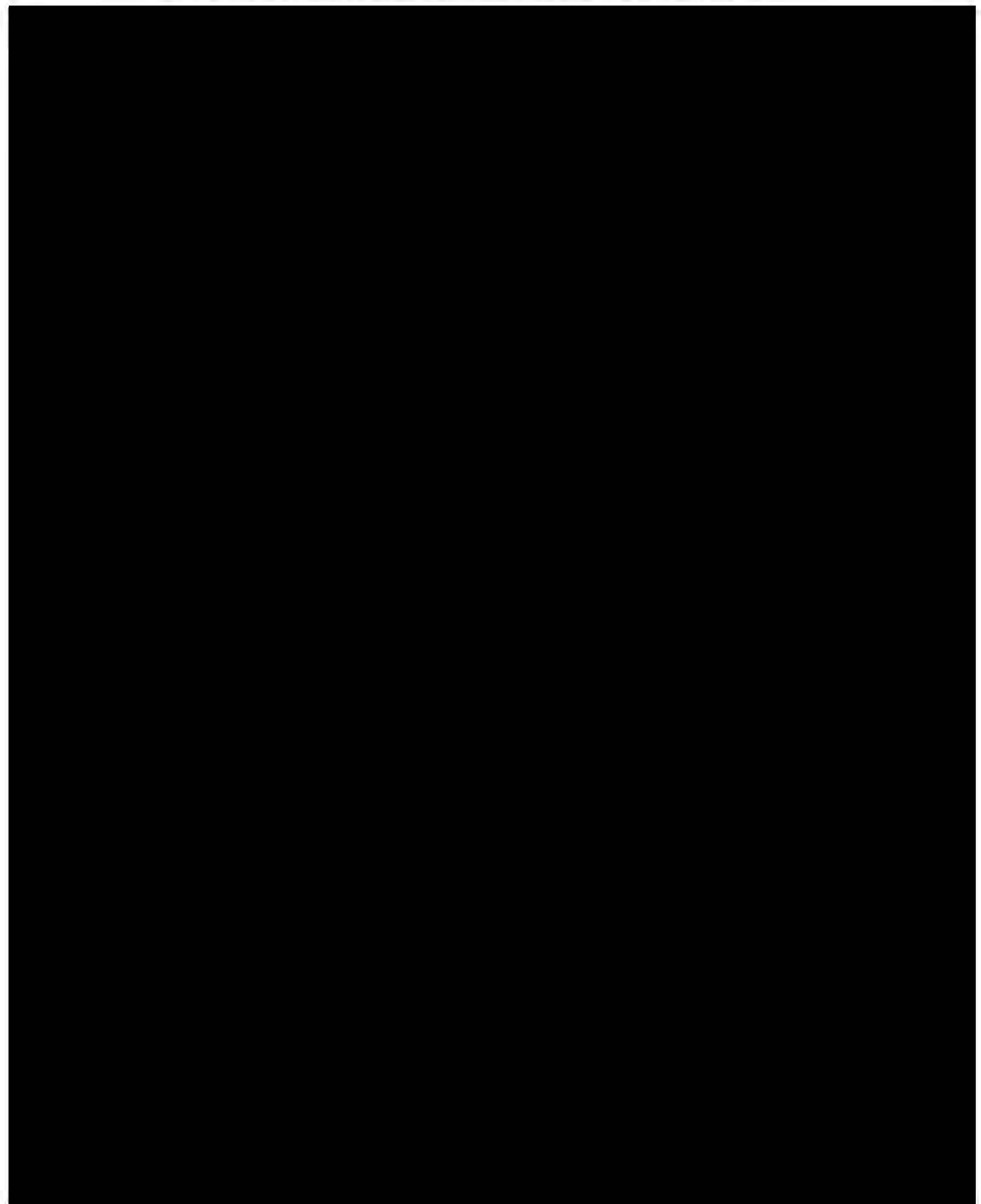

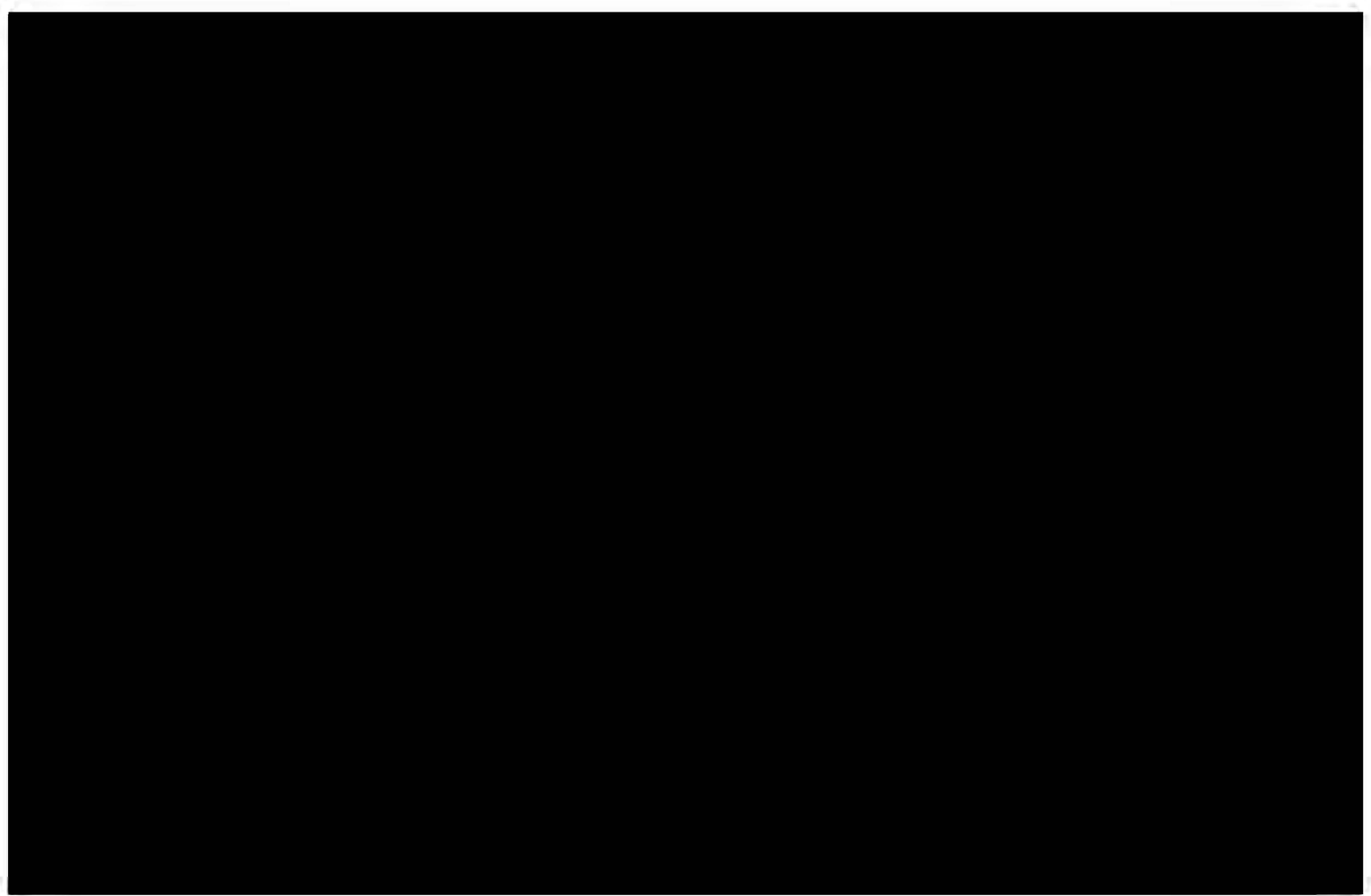
