On 6/21/2018 at 0317 hours, I was dispatched to Circle K at 2011 N Lincoln Ave for a shoplifter not in custody. METCAD advised a black male, wearing a comic book character shirt, red pants, necklace, stole a bottle of Evan Williams and left on foot towards the Knights Inn Hotel.

Upon my arrival, I met with employee [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] informed when the offender left the store with the unpaid bottle of alcohol, he crossed east on Lincoln Ave and continued walking on east on Killarney. [REDACTED] stated as he crossed Lincoln, the offender noticed a police car pulled onto Killarney drive and that's when the offender started walking south behind Andrae's Harley Davidson at 2010 N Lincoln Ave. It was later DEDECKER, COLLIN R officer's initials CO approved JGS (UU1802801)

learned the offender was walking to Knights in due to a group of people having a party. The first squad car the offender noticed was responding to a call for an intoxicated subject (U18-2800). It was also learned the intoxicated subject was a friend of the offender.

I let officers checking the area know the last direction of travel. While I continued talking to [REDACTED] about the incident, Ofc Ruff and Ofc Hayes located a male matching the description, who was later identified as Dominique Allen, behind 2010 N Lincoln Ave. It was later learned that Dominique had a warrant for his arrest. See Ofc Ruff's and Ofc Hayes's report for locating Dominique.

At this time, I asked [REDACTED] to explain to me what happened while Dominique was in the store. [REDACTED] stated Dominique walked in the store and immediately grabbed a bottle of Evan Williams and walked to the counter. While at the counter, Dominique also asked for a pack of cigars. [REDACTED] stated she checked Dominique out and told him it would be \$19.47. [REDACTED] stated Dominique told her he only had \$19.00 dollars. [REDACTED] told Dominique that if he does not have the other 47 cents, she would not be able to sell him the items. Dominique then said to [REDACTED] "Fuck it and cancel the transaction" and started walking out of the store.

While Dominique was walking out of the store, [REDACTED] stated he grabbed another bottle of Evan Williams and said "Fuck it I'm going to take this, what are you going to do call the police" and walked out of the store and started walking towards the Knights Inn.

After getting [REDACTED] statement of the incident, I informed [REDACTED] that officers located a male matching the description she gave METCAD. I asked [REDACTED] if she would be willing to do a show up and she stated yes. I had [REDACTED] get in the back seat of my patrol vehicle and I drove to 2010 N Lincoln Ave where Ofc Ruff and Ofc Hayes located the possible offender.

As I arrived at their location, I asked [REDACTED] if she recognized anyone standing outside the vehicle. [REDACTED] stated she did. I asked [REDACTED] who she recognized and she stated the male dressed in red. I asked [REDACTED] how she recognized the male standing outside. [REDACTED] stated he was the one that stole the bottle of alcohol. I informed officers that it was a positive show up and drove [REDACTED] back to Circle K. While at the store,

████████ provided with a copy of the receipt for the bottle of alcohol and informed me her boss would have to provide me with a copy of surveillance video when they get in later in the day.

I then went back to Ofc Hayes's location to speak with Dominique. At 0406 hours, I read Dominique the Miranda Warning. I asked Dominique if he understood the Miranda Warning and he stated yes. I asked Dominique to tell me what happened while he was at Circle K. Dominique stated he was outside the store while a group of females he was with went inside the store. I asked Dominique if he went inside the store and he stated he did not.

Dominique was later informed that there is video of him inside the store taking the bottle of alcohol and the employee working positively identified him as the one who stole the bottle. Dominique then informed me he stole a bottle of Jack Daniels. I informed Dominique it was a bottle of Evan Williams and he again stated it was a bottle of Jack Daniels. I explained to Dominique that a bottle of Evan Williams was found near where he was seen walking and the employee saw him take a bottle of Evan Williams. Dominique continued to tell officers that it was a bottle of Jack Daniels that he stole.

After speaking with Dominique, Ofc Hayes transported him to the Champaign County Satellite Jail. I then went to where officers located the bottle of Evan Williams and photographed it. The photos were later placed into evidence. After photographing the bottle, I went back to Circle K and returned it. ██████████ then informed me she wanted Dominique trespasses from the business. I filled out a No Trespass Notice and later went to the jail to give Dominique his copy.

**NARRATIVE**

On 6-21-18, at 0317 hrs. I, along with Trainee Officer Hayes assisted with a retail theft that occurred at Circle K, 2011 N Lincoln in Urbana.

I was given information that the suspect, a black male wearing a red shirt and red pants with white shoes had stole liquor from the business. The suspect was last seen running east from the business then south behind 2010 N Lincoln.

Trainee Officer Hayes and I parked our squad car and canvassed the area around 2010 N Lincoln on foot. As we walked on the south side of the building we approached a clearing between the building and another building to the south. I pointed my flashlight in the direction of the clearing and observed a black male wearing a red shirt and red pants laying on the ground behind some brush and next to a fence.

Initially I was unable to see the suspect's hands. I removed my pistol from it's holster and pointed it at the suspect. I gave clear concise verbal commands to the suspect to raise his arms above his head. I then ordered the suspect to stand up. The suspect complied with my commands. When the suspect stood up he stated " you guys got me, you can put your guns away, I didn't steal anything". I ordered the suspect to turn around and face the fence.

Trainee Officer Hayes then placed the suspect in handcuffs. I called out our location and advised METCAD we had detained the suspect. The suspect was then escorted to our squad car.

Officer DeDecker brought the witness to the scene to attempt to identify the suspect. I was informed by Officer DeDecker that the witness positively identified the suspect. Reference Officer DeDecker's report.

**NARRATIVE**

On June 21, 2018 at approximately 0317 hours, Officers were dispatched to 2011 N Lincoln Avenue (Circle K) in reference to a shoplifter.

According to METCAD, the subject was wearing a comic book character shirt, with red pants and a necklace.

Upon arrival, I saw Officer DeDecker speaking to the clerk at Circle K. Officer Ruff and I searched the area starting at Lincoln Avenue and Kettering Park. The search continued back to 613 Killarney (Knights Inn Hotel). I learned from Officer DeDecker the suspect could possibly be staying there.

Officer DeDecker told me the suspect was seen changing direction and walking behind 2010 N Lincoln (Andrae's Harley Davidson). I parked my squad car and Officer Ruff and I got out on foot in the front of 2010 N Lincoln. We walked along the south side of the building. We came to a clearing approaching another building to the south. I looked to my right and Officer Ruff and I pointed our flash lights that direction. I saw a black male in red pants in the crouch position behind some brush up against a fence.

Initially I was only able to see suspect's pants and shoes. I was not able to see his hands. As we walked toward the suspect, I saw Officer Ruff remove his pistol from his holster. I did the same and we pointed our pistols at the suspect. Officer Ruff ordered the suspect to show his hands and slowly stand up. The suspect complied with his commands. As he stood up he stated "you got me, you can put your guns away, I didn't steal anything". Officer Ruff ordered the suspect to turn around and face the fence.

I holstered my weapon and placed the suspect in handcuffs. I made sure HAYES,OSRIC N officer's initials OH approved DS (UU1802801 - #A1807242)



they were checked for proper fit and double locked. I escorted the suspect back to my squad car. I searched the suspect before I placed him in my squad car.

Officer DeDecker brought the witness to my location to attempt to identify the suspect. Officer DeDecker told me that the witness positively identified the suspect. See Officer DeDecker's Report. I gathered accurate field interview information and stood by while until Officer DeDecker was able to speak with him. The suspect was identified as Dominique Allen ([REDACTED]). I transported Allen to the Champaign County Jail, and left him in the care of jail staff.

I cleared this call with this supplemental report.

**NARRATIVE**

On 06/21/18 0308 hours I was dispatched to a call at Knights Inn to assist a victim having a medical emergency.

While en route, I observed a stocky, black male running across N Lincoln Ave at the intersection with Killarney St. This male was wearing red pants and a patterned shirt of some sort. He appeared to be holding something in his hand as he ran. He was running from the southwest corner of the intersection towards the southeast corner towards the Harley-Davidson sign on that corner.

While on the call at Knights Inn, I spoke with [REDACTED] who stated the victim [REDACTED] had been drinking with her son Dominique Allen ([REDACTED]). [REDACTED] advised Dominique had been staying at the hotel, however he was not there at the moment.

While on this call, a shoplifter not in custody at the Circle K at 2011 N Lincoln came out over the radio. METCAD advised the offender had taken a bottle of liquor from the gas station. The description METCAD gave of the offender matched the description of the male I saw running across the intersection. METCAD advised the offender was wearing red pants, a comic book t-shirt, and a necklace.

Before clearing the call at Knights Inn, I spoke with the clerk at the front desk, [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] advised that [REDACTED] son Dominique Allen was wearing a red shirt with some strange pattern on it. [REDACTED] described the male as a stocky, black male with short hair. [REDACTED] advised Dominique had been in and out of the hotel that evening drinking with [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] also stated Dominique was not supposed to be staying at the hotel.

After speaking with [REDACTED], I heard Officer Ruff and Officer Hayes tell GRADY, ALEXANDRIA L officer's initials AR approved AR (UU1802801 - #A1807243)

METCAD they had found a male matching Dominique's description hiding behind Harley-Davidson somewhere. Dominique did not have a bottle of alcohol on his person. Officer McKinney, Sgt. Smysor, and I began to search the area for the liquor. The bottle of liquor was located just next to the Harley-Davidson sign where I had seen Dominique running earlier while I was on my way to Knights Inn.

After relaying this information to other officers, I cleared the scene with this supplemental report.
