REVISED POLICY STATEMENT

The asbestos policy of the school (Local Education Authority (LEA)) is as follows:

We comply with the AHERA rules and regulations as set forth in 40 CFR part 763 of Federal Register on October 30, 1987, and in IDPH Section 855.

Any suspect asbestos containing building material (ACBM) not previously addressed is assumed to contain asbestos until inspected by an EPA/AHERA accredited, IDPH licensed inspector and testing by a NVLAP approved laboratory proves them not to contain asbestos.

The Management Plan was put into effect approximately June 9, 1989.

The Operations and Management Plan is followed to preserve the health and safety of the staff and students.

The material that is damaged or may become damaged will be repaired by an EPA/AHERA accredited, IDPH licensed asbestos worker, such as provided by *IDEAL Environmental Engineering*, *Inc.*

All accessible asbestos areas and repaired material will be maintained in good condition.

All the tunnel/crawlspace areas containing damaged asbestos will be repaired within one year and maintained, or the spaces will be locked and sealed, with entry permitted only by EPA/AHERA accredited, IDPH licensed asbestos workers wearing respirators and disposable suits.

Warning labels are posted on all known or assumed ACBM in all maintenance areas to indicate that asbestos is present.

The building occupants are notified once a year of the availability of the Management Plan, and asbestos related activities, and the dated notification will be filed in the Management Plan(s).

If all the asbestos is removed or the material is determined not to contain asbestos, the building occupants will be notified each year of the availability of the Management Plan.

We require all outside contractors to obtain a work permit before undertaking remodeling or repair work. The contractor will be notified of the Management Plan(s) and the location of any asbestos areas that must not be disturbed.

REVISED POLICY STATEMENT (CONTINUED)

We will provide an in-house asbestos coordinator for our school's asbestos program. Our in-house asbestos coordinator is: Name
The Asbestos Designated Person will oversee any minor removal of up to three square feet or three linear feet of asbestos, or the cleanup of any minor fiber release, and will ensure that six-month surveillances are completed.
If funds become available to remove any asbestos containing building material such as prior to any repair, remodeling, renovation or demolition work, we will use an EPA/AHERA accredited IDPH licensed designer, such as provided by <i>IDEAL</i> , to design the project and supply project managers/air sampling professionals for the removal work.
We only employ EPA/AHERA accredited IDPH licensed contractors and workers to complete the response actions.
This policy statement may be revised at any time, and the management plan may be updated as needed. LEA ADMINISTRATOR DATE

	All short-term workers (phone workers, utility workers, exterminators, plumbers, electricians, etc.) must sign a work permit verifying that they were provided information regarding locations of known or assumed asbestos areas.			
	Warning labels must be posted in routine maintenance areas such as boiler rooms, etc. on or adjacent to any known or assumed asbestos areas.			
	Buildings leased, acquired, or put into use on or after October 12, 1988, as a school building (as defined by AHERA) must be inspected for asbestos and have a management plan developed <u>prior</u> to school use.			

	Management plan updates such as Six-Month Surveillance forms, Notification letters, O&M Activities, Response Action Activities, Reinspections, etc. should be in or with every plan book. If the plan book cannot be added to, or is full, a new three-ring binder should be started for this type of recordkeeping.
	Any new building material such as drywall, floor tile, carpet, mastic, ceiling tile, etc., must have a Material Data Safety Sheets (MSDS) to prove there is no asbestos content in the material. A binder of MSDS sheets should be maintained with your asbestos program on all newly added building materials.

General Comments

The only way to assure all suspect asbestos areas are addressed is to perform a full asbestos inspection survey, which is not included in the Three-Year Reinspection or Three-Year Reinspection price.
