Our records for advance registration for the January 28th Board meeting reflect that you have registered to speak. However, on August 1, 2014, we notified you in writing that you forfeited your right of reentry to future Chicago Board of Education meetings. A copy of that August 1, 2014 letter is enclosed for your convenience. As stated in the letter, you forfeited your right of reentry when you violated the Public Participation Guidelines for Conduct at Chicago Board of Education Meetings by engaging in highly charged disruptive behavior during the July 23, 2014 meeting.

You will not be permitted to attend or speak at the January 28th Board meeting or future Board meetings until further notice. However, you are able to utilize alternative means of communication with the Board such as: 1) submitting written testimony to the Board pursuant to Section Eight of the Guidelines; and/or 2) seeking to meet with Board members via monthly office hours.
