We have reviewed all relevant records and have attached the responsive records. Please note that portions of the records you have requested are exempt from disclosure because of one or more of the FOIA exemptions listed below. Therefore, we have redacted these portions from the records being released to you. The person responsible for this partial denial is Freedom of Information Officer Curt Borman.

5 ILCS 140/7(1)(b) exempts "private information" or rather, unique identifiers such as "an individual's social security number, driver's license number, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when compiled without possibility of attribution to any person." 5 ILCS 140/2(c-5).

- 5 ILCS 140/7(1)(c) exempts "personal information" contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, unless the disclosure is consented to in writing by the individual subjects of the information. "Unwarranted invasion of personal privacy" means the disclosure of information that is highly personal or objectionable to a reasonable person and in which the subject's right to privacy outweighs any legitimate public interest in obtaining the information. The disclosure of information that bears on the public duties of public employees and officials shall not be considered an invasion of personal privacy.
- 5 ILCS 140/7(1)(f) exempts "Preliminary drafts, notes, recommendations, memoranda and other records in which opinions are expressed, or policies or actions are formulated, except that a specific record or relevant portion of a record shall not be exempt when the record is publicly cited and identified by the head of the public body. The exemption provided in this paragraph (f) extends to all those records of officers and agencies of the General Assembly that pertain to the preparation of legislative documents."

If you believe any records you are seeking have been wrongfully withheld or redacted, you are entitled to a review of this decision by the Public Access Counselor of the Office of the Illinois Attorney General. - 4. 5 ILCS 140/7 (g) exempts trade secrets and commercial or financial information obtained from a person or business where the trade secrets or commercial or financial information are furnished under a claim that they are proprietary, privileged or confidential, and that disclosure of the trade secrets or commercial or financial information would cause competitive harm to the person or business, and only insofar as the claim directly applies to the records requested.
- 5. 5 ILCS 140/7(1)(m) exempts communications between a public body and an attorney or auditor representing the public body that would not be subject to discovery in litigation, and materials prepared or compiled by or for a public body in anticipation of a criminal, civil or administrative proceeding upon the request of an attorney advising the public body, and materials prepared or compiled with respect to internal audits of public bodies.
